FDLE has 14 positions assigned to the examination of paint, polymer, fibers, glass, and bulb filament evidence. The examination of this evidence, sometimes no larger than numbers on a penny can associate a person with a place or another person. Comparisons may include glass from a suspect's clothes compared with broken glass from a crime scene; cut, broken or torn objects to determine if they were parts of the same object; light bulb filaments from a car in a hit and run; paint comparisons to a suspect vehicle or to identify make and model of a vehicle; or fibers that may have been transferred between individuals involved in a crime. While trace evidence analysis can help in many types of cases, the majority of cases worked by this discipline are related to vehicular homicide and hit and run investigations. In FY 15-16, 363 requests for this service were received from law enforcement contributors.

Eliminating this service would have a major impact on Florida Highway Patrol and other local law enforcement contributors that would have to fund outsourcing the analysis to a private consultant or vendor.

The Questioned Documents discipline, which consists of three positions, is a service offered out of FDLE's Pensacola laboratory, which provides document examination for law enforcement agencies across the state. In FY 15-16, there were 184 requests for documents examination.

Eliminating this service would impact Florida's law enforcement contributors that would have to pay to outsource the analysis to a private consultant or vendor. The State Attorney's Office would have to pay for expert witness fees.

FDLE has six positions assigned to analyze impressions which include such evidence as footwear and tire impressions that may have been left at a crime scene. Footwear can be as individual as a fingerprint, and tires undergo unique transformations as they wear down which can be compared to photographs, lifts, or casts taken from the crime scene. In FY 15-16, 210 requests for this service were received from law enforcement contributors in Florida.

Eliminating this service would have a major impact on Florida Highway Patrol and other local law enforcement contributors that would have to seek the service through mutual aid agreements with other agencies within the state or pay to outsource the analysis to a private consultant or vendor.

FDLE has eight crime scene analysts who are on call 24/7 and respond to requests for examination of major crime scenes throughout the state. The proper documentation, collection and preservation of physical evidence are critical to the successful outcome of criminal investigations. Crime scene processing includes photography, video recording, measuring, sketching, evidence collection and bloodstain pattern analysis. FDLE received 396 crime scene service requests statewide in FY 15-16.

Some medium to large law enforcement agencies have crime scene service within their agencies, but most small agencies do not. Eliminating this service statewide would require local law enforcement agencies to process their own crime scenes, or seek the service through mutual aid agreements with other agencies within the state.

FDLE first began offering computer evidence recovery services in the crime laboratory in the late 1990s. At that time the service consisted primarily of retrieving data files from standalone computer hard drives and floppy disks. Along with the explosive growth in the sophistication of digital technology and the use of computers and other digital media involvement in nearly every type of crime, the job of the forensic analyst has become much more advanced, intricate and time consuming. Digital Evidence, as the discipline is now called, involves retrieval and analysis of data stored on (and deep within) cell phones, tablets, hard drives, removable media, as well as simple and very complex computer networks.

FDLE has a total of nine crime laboratory analysts providing digital evidence analysis services to criminal justice agencies throughout the state. The advancement in capability within the digital evidence discipline has contributed to a significant increase in the work load. In the past five years, incoming requests for service have increased by 51 percent. The increased volume of digital evidence work without an increase in the number of analysts assigned to the discipline contributed to a 200 percent increase in the number of pending digital evidence service requests statewide between June 2010 and June 2015. Given the growth in digital media usage, it is anticipated that the demand for digital forensic analysis services will continue to grow. Without committing additional resources, pending service requests will continue to escalate.

Elimination of forensic digital evidence analysis would require local agencies to rely on their own in-house digital evidence expertise, which many mid and large size agencies have developed to at least a basic level, the Federal Bureau of Investigation crime laboratory or commercially available digital forensic analysis services.

A portion of fines assessed as a result of driving/boating under the influence and drug contraband convictions that are collected by Clerks of the Court across Florida are deposited into the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's (FDLE) Operating Trust Fund. These funds are distributed on a quarterly basis to five county-operated forensic laboratories (Broward, Indian River, Miami-Dade, Palm Beach and Pinellas) to be applied toward their current year actual operating costs. Funds are based on actual collections of fines during the quarter and disbursements may not exceed 75 percent of

Economic crime includes a wide range of fraudulent activities that are generally complex, involve multiple victims, and have a significant negative impact on the state's residents, visitors, and overall economy. These investigations are often protracted, require special training, and investigative expertise to successfully disrupt the criminal organization/activity. Examples of the types of investigation included in this category are organized retail theft, cargo theft, mortgage fraud, identity theft, and other major schemes to defraud including fraud against state government, that are responsible for millions of dollars in business and tax revenue losses each year. In FY 15-16, FDLE worked 290 major economic crime cases. Most local law enforcement agencies do not have the financial or investigative resources, or the jurisdictional authority to pursue organized fraud investigations.

Elimination of economic crime resources would require local agencies to develop their own expertise in financial investigations or rely upon the Department of Financial Services or the Federal Bureau of Investigation to handle these cases.

Incidents involving police and corrections personnel use of force and in-custody death incidents attract media attention and invite public scrutiny. Florida law enforcement agencies often request an independent investigation to alleviate citizen concerns and eliminate any perception that internal investigations may be biased. Independent, impartial investigations of this nature are imperative to maintain trust between the criminal justice community and the citizens of Florida.

In FY 14-15, the Legislature appropriated the department 17 special agent positions to investigate cases of serious injury or death on Department of Corrections (DOC) institutional property or in connection with DOC care, custody, or control of inmates while off institutional property. Until that time, FDLE assisted DOC at the request of the DOC Inspector General's Office or pursuant to Executive Order, but was not the primary investigating authority for this type of crime. In FY 15-16, FDLE worked 148 major cases related to DOC cases involving death or serious injury, representing an increase of over 600 percent from FY 13-14.

If these positions are eliminated, FDLE will not be able to sustain the current level of commitment to DOC-related investigations of death and serious injury. The responsibility for these investigations will revert to the DOC Office of Inspector General or another law enforcement entity.

In 2011, 17 Florida Attorney General's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) positions were merged with FDLE's Florida Cyber Crime Center, thereby consolidating the state's cybercrime assets and allowing FDLE to expand cybercrime capabilities. Cyber assets were deployed to each of FDLE's regional operations centers and FDLE began to put a strategy in place that included assistance to local agencies with cybercrime investigations and training local law enforcement in the use of cyber tools and protocols. Most of the cybercrime cases to date have been in the area of Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC). Today many local law enforcement agencies have developed ICAC investigators and although these types of cases still represent a significant portion of FDLE cybercrime workload, the development of the local agency capabilities is allowing FDLE to expand its cybercrime programs.

If FDLE's role in ICAC is eliminated, the primary responsibility for handling these cases will fall to Florida's local law enforcement agencies, not all of whom have developed the internet investigative expertise. Agencies that have not developed this expertise will have to rely on the availability of mutual aid partners to assist in the investigation. Loss of these assets will also impact the continued development of the state's expertise and capacity to investigate sophisticated hacking, intrusion and denials of services cases, leaving Florida's public largely without an investigative avenue except on cases that meet the Federal Bureau of Investigation's relatively narrow investigative parameters.

Currently, there are approximately 68,000 known sexual offenders and an additional 16,000 career offenders either in the state or with ties to Florida. In May 2015 there were approximately 775 sexual offenders and 301 career offenders that were reported to be absconded based on lack of compliance with registration requirements. Due to the nature of the crimes they have already committed, unregistered career offenders are considered to be the most violent offenders in our state. Currently, one third of the released career offender population (approximately 1,250) are either not registered, or registered incorrectly. As a result, their whereabouts are unknown and they are not accounted for on the FDLE Career Offender Registry.

In 2005, the Legislature passed the Jessica Lunsford Act to strengthen registration timelines, and provided FDLE with positions to provide analytical support to local law enforcement to assist in identifying and locating sex offenders who were not following registration requirements. In 2014, FDLE supplemented the unit with Inspectors to work with local and federal officers to assist in the arrest of non-compliant offenders. To date, the Enforcement Apprehension Team has arrested 216 offenders and brought another 104 offenders into compliance with Florida registration laws.

Elimination of Criminal Justice Professionalism Field Services would remove oversight over local criminal justice agency officer certification; potentially allowing individuals who are not qualified or statutorily ineligible to become certified as an officer. Additional oversight over the 40 certified training schools and their expenditure of \$5.1 million annually would be diminished.

The Drug Abuse Resistance Education program (DARE) is a law enforcement officer-led series of classroom lessons that teach children from kindergarten through high school how to make good decisions and wise choices. The curriculum covers a wide range of risks that children face daily, including drug use, bullying, violence, and gangs. DARE has been a part of FDLE since 1988, when FDLE was designated as the statewide training center to provide administrative oversight to the program in Florida. However, s. 233.0663, F.S., was repealed by the Legislature in 2002.

Elimination of DARE would require another entity to assume the role of statewide administrator and training center for the program to continue to be a resource for Florida school districts and local law enforcement agencies.

The Florida Criminal Justice Executive Institute (FCJEI) was established in 1990 to provide criminal justice executives with quality leadership training that is unique to Florida's complex issues. Since its creation, the FCJEI has expanded its programs to consist of training from first line supervisors through chief executives and all ranks in between. The Leadership Center provides internal training for FDLE members, provides on-line training for local criminal justice officers to help fulfill their required continuing education training, and provides specialized training for crime intelligence analysts from all criminal justice agencies.

Elimination of the FCJEI would force local criminal justice agencies to seek leadership based training from entities not familiar with the specific issues facing Florida. Elimination of the Leadership Center would force local criminal justice agencies to send their officers to classroom instruction to obtain required continuing education training and their analysts to intelligence training outside of Florida. In addition, FDLE would be forced to seek training for its members from an outside source. These training alternatives, in many cases, would be cost prohibitive to state and local participants.
