FDLE has 14 positions assigned to the examination of paint, polymer, fibers, glass, and bulb filament evidence. The examination of this evidence, sometimes no larger than numbers on a penny, can associate a person with a place or another person. Comparisons may include glass from a suspect's clothes compared with broken glass from a crime scene; cut, broken or torn objects to determine if they were parts of the same object; light bulb filaments from a car in a hit and run; paint comparisons to a suspect vehicle or to identify make and model of a vehicle; or fibers that may have been transferred between individuals involved in a crime. While trace evidence analysis can help in many types of cases, the majority of cases worked by this discipline are related to vehicular homicide and hit and run investigations. In fiscal year 2016/17, 128 requests for this service were received from law enforcement contributors.

FDLE has 8 crime scene analysts who are on call 24/7 and respond to requests for examination of major crime scenes throughout the state. The proper documentation, collection and preservation of physical evidence are critical to the successful outcome of criminal investigations. Crime scene processing includes photography, video recording, measuring, sketching, evidence collection and bloodstain pattern analysis. FDLE received 212 crime scene service requests statewide in fiscal year 2016/17.

Some medium to large law enforcement agencies have crime scene service within their agencies, but most small agencies do not. Eliminating this service statewide would require local law enforcement agencies to process their own crime scenes, or seek the service through mutual aid agreements with other agencies within the state.

FDLE first began offering computer evidence recovery services in the crime laboratory in the late 1990s. At that time the service consisted primarily of retrieving data files from standalone computer hard drives and floppy disks. Along with the explosive growth in the sophistication of digital technology and the use of computers and other digital media involvement in nearly every type of crime, the job of the forensic analyst has become much more advanced, intricate and time consuming. Digital Evidence, as the discipline is now called, involves retrieval and analysis of data stored on (and deep within) cell phones, tablets, hard drives, removable media, as well as simple and very complex computer networks.

FDLE has a total of nine crime laboratory analysts providing digital evidence analysis services to criminal justice agencies throughout the state. The advancement in capability within the digital evidence discipline has contributed to a significant increase in the work load. In FY 2016/17 FDLE received 444 requests for digital evidence analysis which is an increase of 5% over the past five years.— Given the growth in digital media usage, it is anticipated that the demand for digital forensic analysis services will continue to grow. Without committing additional resources, pending service requests will continue to escalate.

Elimination of forensic digital evidence analysis would require local agencies to rely on their own in-house digital evidence expertise, which many mid and large size agencies have developed to at least a basic level, the FBI crime laboratory or commercially available digital forensic analysis services.

Economic crime includes a wide range of fraudulent activities that are generally complex, involve multiple victims, and have a significant negative impact on the state's residents, visitors, and overall economy. These investigations are often protracted, require special training, and investigative expertise to successfully disrupt the criminal organization/activity. Examples of the types of investigation included in this category are organized retail theft, cargo theft, mortgage fraud, identity theft, and other major schemes to defraud including fraud against state government, that are responsible for millions of dollars in business and tax revenue losses each year. Currently, there are approximately 71,000 known sexual offenders and an additional 17,000 career offenders either in the state or with ties to Florida. In July 2017 there were approximately 800 sexual offenders and 270 career offenders that were reported to be absconded based on lack of compliance with registration requirements. Due to the nature of the crimes they have already committed, unregistered career offenders are considered to be the most violent offenders in our state. Currently, approximately 20% or 1250 of the released career offender population are not registered. As a result, their whereabouts are unknown and they are not accounted for on the FDLE Career Offender Registry.

In 2005, the Florida Legislature passed the Jessica Lunsford Act to strengthen registration timelines, and provided FDLE with positions to provide analytical support to local law enforcement to assist in identifying and locating sex offenders who were not following registration requirements. In 2014, FDLE supplemented the unit with Inspectors to work with local and federal officers to assist in the arrest of non-compliant offenders. To date the Enforcement Apprehension Team has arrested 340 offenders and brought another 292 offenders into compliance with Florida registration laws.

In 2011 the 17 Florida Attorney General's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) positions merged with the Florida Cyber Crime Center at FDLE consolidating the state's cybercrime assets and allowing FDLE to expand cybercrime capabilities throughout the state. Currently, there are approximately 71,000 known sexual offenders and an additional 17,000 career offenders either in the state or with ties to Florida. In July 2017 there were approximately 800 sexual offenders and 270 career offenders that were reported to be absconded based on lack of compliance with registration requirements. Due to the nature of the crimes they have already committed, unregistered career offenders are considered to be the most violent offenders in our state. Currently, approximately 20% or 1250 of the released career offender population are not registered. As a result, their whereabouts are unknown and they are not accounted for on the FDLE Career Offender Registry.

In 2005, the Florida Legislature passed the Jessica Lunsford Act to strengthen registration timelines, and provided FDLE with positions to provide analytical support to local law enforcement to assist in identifying and locating sex offenders who were not following registration requirements. In 2014, FDLE supplemented the unit with Inspectors to work with local and federal officers to assist in the arrest of non-compliant offenders. To date the Enforcement Apprehension Team has arrested 340 offenders and brought another 292 offenders into compliance with Florida registration laws.

Program has been a part of FDLE since 1988, when FDLE was designated as the statewide training center to provide administrative oversight to the program in Florida. FDLE has continued to administer the program even after s. 233.0663, F.S., was repealed by the Legislature in 2002.

Elimination of D.A.R.E. would require another entity to assume the role of statewide administrator and training center for the program to continue to be a resource for Florida school districts and local law enforcement agencies.

The FAO is responsible for coordinating the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA) and the Florida Corrections Accreditation Commission meetings (FCAC); conducting outreach to agencies in all disciplines; providing training to assessors, accreditation managers and the accreditation community; assisting agencies in achieving accreditation; and acting as an information and materials resource for individuals and agencies participating in the process. As of July 1, 2017, there are 231agencies accredited through the two state accreditation commissions, which provides a financially and programmatically responsible alternative to national accreditation organizations.

If the FAO is eliminated, the referenced Commissions would be required to obtain an alternate source of funding to staff and administer their programs.
