The estimated impact of this reduction is \$837.5 million less in sales and \$155.8 million less in contributions to the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund as the Department would need to limit sales to match appropriations in order to meet contractual obligations.

The Department proposes a reduction in the amount of \$11,641,194 in the Instant Ticket Purchase appropriation category to meet the target reduction.
