The Florida Gaming Control Commission, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering proposes a reduction of \$1,916,000 in the Pari-Mutuel Laboratory Contracted Services category.

This contract is with the University of Florida, College of Medicine, Department of Pathology, for the day-to-day operations for testing the blood and urine samples collected from racing horses by division personnel at each of the state's horseracing and greyhound tracks.

The current appropriation amount is \$1,916,000. Reduction will change the appropriation to \$0. Therefore, due to the high fixed costs for lab testing equipment, it is unknown if the University of Florida could continue to provide testing if the appropriation was fully taken.

The University of Florida is the only known testing lab in Florida, and the division would likely need to outsource the testing to an out of state racing lab if the University of Florida could no longer perform this service.

Note that effective January 1, 2021, greyhound racing was prohibited in Florida reducing the volume of specimen samples tested by the racing lab.

This reduction will have a significant impact on the Commission.

The Florida Gaming Control Commission, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering proposes a reduction of \$70,000 in the Racing Animal Medical Research Contract category.

The contract is with the University of Florida College of Veterinary Medicine to conduct research of the effect of certain drugs, medications or substances on thoroughbreds. The current appropriation amount is \$100,000.

Reduction will change the appropriation to \$30,000.

This reduction would have a moderate impact on the Commission.

The Florida Gaming Control Commission (FGCC), Division of Slot Machine Regulation proposes a reduction of \$785,203 in the Compulsive and Addictive Gambling Prevention Contract category.

This contract which is required by Section 551.118(2), Florida Statutes; Section 551.118(3) requires each slot licensee to pay the division an annual fee of \$250,000 for the Compulsive and Addictive Gambling Prevention Program.

The contract is with the Florida Council on Compulsive Gambling (FCCG). The FCCG provides assistance to problem gamblers through a 24-hour helpline, and provides outdoor, radio, TV, and print advertising. It also provides training and materials to slot facilities for employees to recognize problem gambling.

The current appropriation of \$1,250,000 for this contract represents approximately 25% of the Slot Machine Regulation operating budget.

Remaining resources would struggle with supporting the operations of the Division and its ability to meet statutorily required goals with the FCCG.

This reduction for Compulsive and Addictive Gambling Prevention Contract would be reduced from \$1,250,000 to \$464,797.

This reduction would have a significant impact on the Commission.
