A \$295,000 reduction in Sadowski Programs will result in fewer units of affordable housing being funded. Programs impacted may be rental or homeownership programs. Florida Housing's Board of Directors makes the specific program allocations after the actual appropriations are known based on market conditions and demand at that time.

A \$590,000 reduction in the SHIP program will result in fewer dollars being disbursed to the local governments and fewer affordable housing units being funded. Of the 120 local governments currently funded by SHIP, 96 will receive fewer funds with the reductions ranging from just under \$156 to over \$37,611, depending on population. The twenty four counties receiving the statutory minimum allocation cannot be reduced.
