*** ABOUT FACE ***

The Department and the Florida National Guard are working in conjunction with the Department of Children & Families to provide life-skills and drug awareness training, including mentoring assistance for economically disadvantaged and at-risk youths ages 13 through 17. The program is held at local National Guard armories in pre-selected areas throughout the State. Since its inception in 1997, over 4,500 participants have successfully completed the Program.

*** FORWARD MARCH ***

The Department and the Florida National Guard are working in conjunction with the Department of Children & Families to provide job-readiness services for WAGES recipients. All skills are reality-based, allowing the participants to see the relevance of the skills they are learning as well as give them an opportunity to practice those skills in a real-life setting. The program is a community support of the Florida National Guard and is held at selected armories around the State.

These programs are funded with funds transferred from the Agency for Workforce Innovation (AWI). The execution of these funds is contingent upon a contractual agreement between the Department and AWI. The Department has contracted with The Paxen Group to carry out the Programs.
