AGENCY ISSUE NARRATIVE:

SCH VIIIB-2 NARR 12-13 NARRATIVE: IT COMPONENT? NO
 The Florida Building Commission proposes a \$226,138 reduction in the Other Personal Services (OPS) appropriation category related to hurricane protection standards expenditures. The Florida Building Code establishes standards for the construction of buildings to withstand the impact of hurricanes. In response to the 2004 and 2005 hurricanes that impacted Florida a research program was established to develop appropriate construction standards to address buildings failures experienced during those storms. Prior Legislatures established several initiatives for energy conservation that required adaptation of the Florida Energy Code. These initiatives would be reduced and funding stretched over a longer period thus slowing the progress in the development of hurricane protection standards and solutions.

SCH VIIIB-2 NARR 12-13 NARRATIVE: IT COMPONENT? NO
 The Florida Building Commission proposes a \$14,111 reduction in the Expenses appropriation category related to the Building Code Information System (BCIS) and Commission meeting expenditures. The web based Building Code Information System is the core business tool for the public to interface with the Florida Building Commission and the Department. This tool is continually maintained and updated to improve efficiencies in business functions such as product approvals, manufactured building approvals and the Florida Building Code development. Funding of the updates would be reduced and stretched over a longer period and funding for maintenance of equipment utilized for the BCIS would be also be deferred.
