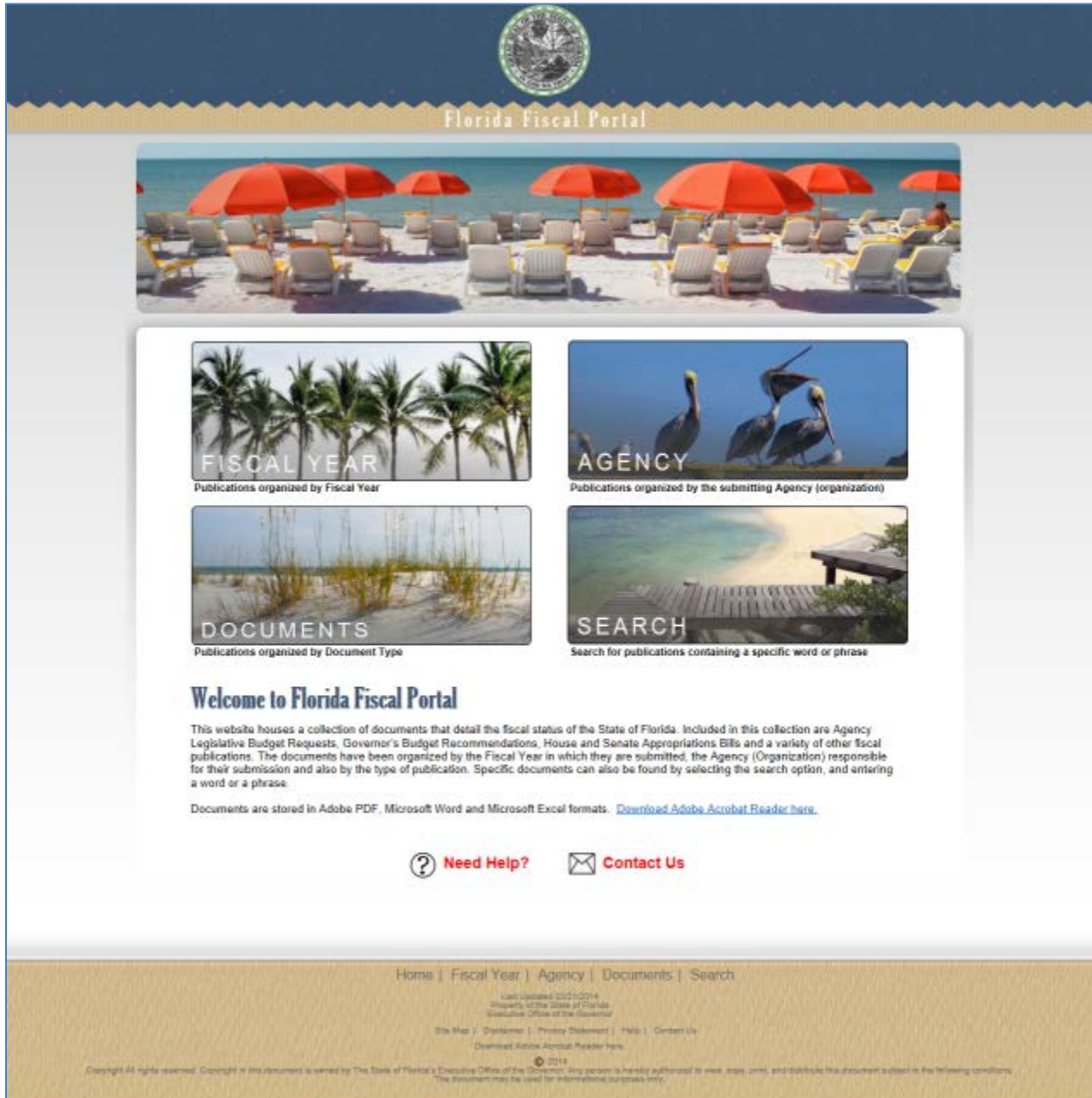


# FLORIDA FISCAL PORTAL - HELP

The Florida Fiscal Portal is a public website containing a collection of documents that details the fiscal status of the State of Florida. Enter the following URL to go to the website's Home page.

## Florida Fiscal Portal Home Page

Documents are organized by three categories: the Fiscal Year in which they were submitted, the Agency (organization) that submitted the information, and by the type of publication. The pictures on the left side of the home page are hyperlinks that allow you to sort the documents by each category.

## Organize by Fiscal Year

To display the documents by fiscal year, click on the **Fiscal Year** picture on the left side of the page.

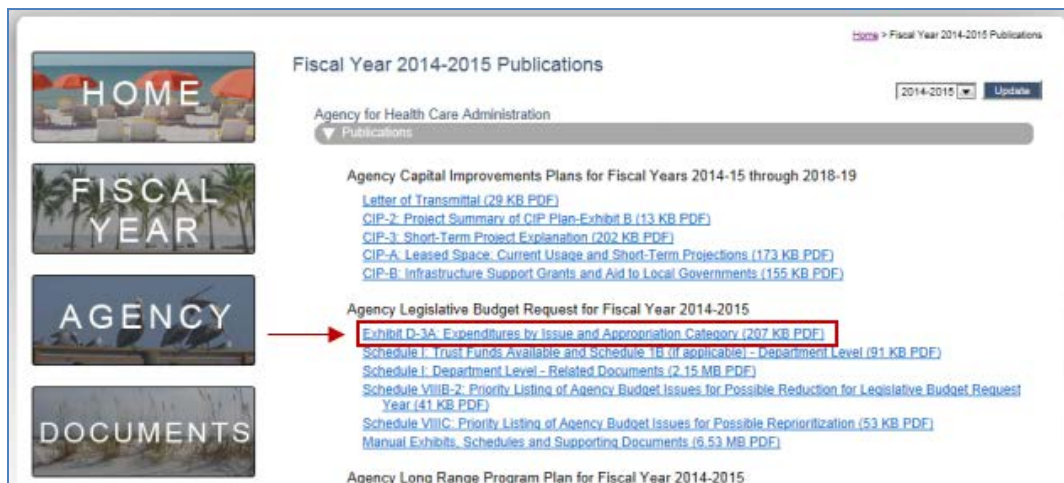


Publications organized by Fiscal Year

Documents for the most recent fiscal year will be listed in alphabetical order by agency. Click on the **Publications** hyperlink beneath the agency's name to view the list of documents submitted by that agency.

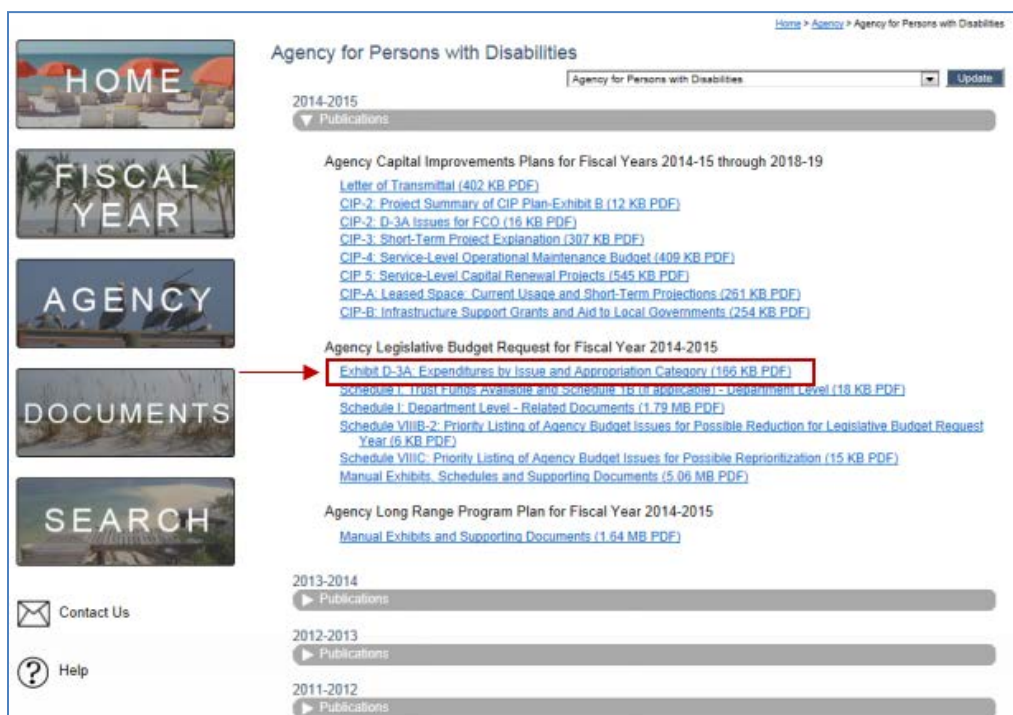

To see publications for a different agency, select the agency from the dropdown list and click the **Update** button.

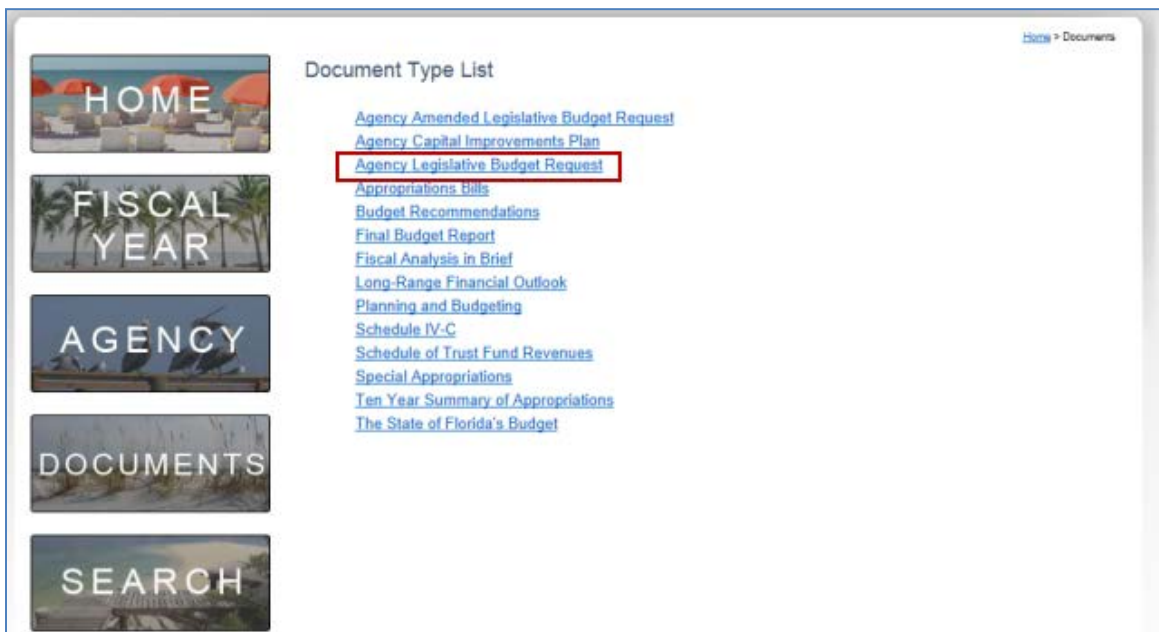


## Organize by Document Type

## Search

To search for documents that have a particular word or phrase, click the **Search** picture on the left side of the page.



To search all documents on the website, enter a word or phrase in the textbox and click the **Search** button.

**Note:** Certain words are invalid for the search function. Click the **Invalid Search Words** hyperlink for a complete list of prohibited words.

## Filtered Search

To narrow the search to a particular fiscal year, agency, and/or document type, enter the word or phrase in the textbox, click the appropriate **Filter By** hyperlinks, and make your selections. Click the **Search** button.
